LOW INFLOW OF INVESTMENTS FROM PAKISTAN TO BiH

Representatives of the National Defense University of Pakistan visited the Foreign Investment Promotion Agency in BiH (FIPA) to have information about the economic cooperation between BiH and Pakistan. Director Milinić welcomed the Pakistani delegation, and informed it on the Agency's responsibilities, cooperating with other BiH institutions and embassies in the field of attracting investments. He recalled the previous meetings with Pakistani businessmen which, unfortunately, did not result in investment.

The registered inflow of investments from Pakistan to BiH is less than BAM 100,000 and therefore there is space for its improvement. Advantages and reasons for investing in BiH were presented, emphasizing the existence of signed preferential trade agreements / EU, CEFTA, EFTA, including the status of foreign investors in BiH, as well as investment sectors.

Available investment projects of the military industry as well as projects of other sectors of BiH were presented to the delegation, including information on the realization of possible strategic projects and possibilities for cooperation with BiH companies in the military industry.



BIH WINE WERE PRESENTED AT FAMOUS FAIR IN TOKYO, JAPAN

2 kinds of BiH wine from VINO Manastir Tvrdoš (Trebinje) Vranac 2015, and from Vinogradi Nuić (Ljubuski) Pošip 2015 were presented and sold at 95th World Liquor and Cheese Festival, very famous wine fair in Tokyo, Japan, which was held from 10 to 16 April.

More than 1000 kinds of wine from 28 countries were exhibited and sold at high-grade department store named DAIMARU. During the 7 days event, about 25000 bottles of wine were sold, and it is one of the biggest wine fair in Japan.

The FIPA Country Representative in Japan, Shigehiko Nishihama supported this fair to introduce the BiH wine to Japanese consumers directly. From January 2014, for the first time, BiH started exporting wine to Japan. For having these results, Mr Nishihama made important efforts.

Japanese import company named M & P Corporation (Tokyo) decided to import the BiH wine from 2 wineries, Vinogradi Nuić and VINO Manastir Tvrdoš. Consumers of Japanese market are satisfied with high quality of the BiH wine and enjoyed tasting special original grape, Vranac and Pošip. At this fair, the BiH wine from local original grape, Blatina and Žilavka were not sold, but M & P Corporation deals with both of them, Blatina and Žilavka are also popular and well received in Japan, too.

Besides the wine presentation, he also presented culture and tourism of BiH to Japanese visitors at this fair, which was important contribution to Bosnia and Herzegovina at the Japanese market.



INTENSIFY THE WAY TO ANIMATE POTENTIAL INVESTORS

Within the preparations for the diplomatic mission, the newly-appointed BiH diploma Slaviša Čeranić, Ambassador of BiH to Romania, and Siniša Berjan, Ambassador of BiH to Japan, visited FIPA in order to have information on the Agency's competencies, cooperation with foreign investors and current activities at field of economic cooperation with the mentioned countries. FIPA Director Gordan Milinić informed Ambassadors about the work of the Agency in the field of foreign investment, work with and support to foreign investors in BiH, currently available investment projects, and sectors that could be of interest to investors from Romania and Japan. He also referred to the growth trend of foreign investments in 2017 and 2018 when we recorded BAM 800 million, highlighting expectations of continued growth during 2019. More significant effects of the economic diplomacy are expected in the field of exports from BiH and the finding of investors for BiH. It is therefore very important, after taking office, to establish contacts with economic and regional chambers of commerce, as well as associations of entrepreneurs and sectorial associations in order to present the potentials of BiH, as well as intensify the way to animate potential investors. According to the official data of the Central Bank of BH, the current investments of Romania in BiH amount to BAM 3.4 million, while the most important Romanian companies are Steel Mehanika, Corrado Penna and Astra Invest. No significant foreign investment in BiH was registered in Japan. The effects of several visits of Japanese economic delegations in BiH in the past two or three years are expected in the near future. It is important to note that Japan is one of the largest donors in BiH.

Importance of organizing business meetings between BiH and foreign businessmen has been highlighted in order to strengthen economic ties, increase investments, and follow economic events in order to involve BiH business and businessmen in new business flows. It was agreed that Ambassadors organize investment forums for BiH in the near future.



FIPA AT THE SARAJEVO BUSINESS FORUM 2019

Representatives of FIPA, led by Director Gordan Milinić, also took part this year at the Sarajevo Business Forum from April 17-19, with the aim to establish contacts with new potential investors for BiH.

Within the conference, investment projects were presented in the fields of agriculture, tourism, wood sector, infrastructure, metal sector, auto parts production and real estate. Meetings with investors were held, to whom were presented possibilities and advantages for investing in BiH.

Director Milinić participated in a panel dedicated to the regional platform for attracting international investors in the region, explaining the reasons why BiH is interested to foreign investors, as well as the need for significant promotion of BiH and its potential abroad.



FIPA AT INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ZAGREB INVEST 2019

Director of the Foreign Investment Promotion Agency of BiH (FIPA) Gordan Milinić is participating at the International Investment Conference Zagreb Invest 2019, which attracted a large number of foreign investors, representatives of the industry, trade and financial sector, and the authorities of the regional countries.

At the conference, Mr Milinić spoke about the possibilities for investing in BiH, attractive sectors and opportunities offered by BiH to foreign investors, processes that are being implemented in order to reform the business environment, and the trends of foreign investment growth in the country. He pointed out that Croatia occupies the 2nd place on the list of investor countries in BiH with EUR 1,182 billion invested, representing 17.2% of total investments registered so far. A large number of Croatian companies that operate successfully in BiH, some of them are Atlantic Group, Belupo, Vindi, Kraš, Dukat, Ina, and many others.

At the end of the presentation, Director invited the investors to invest in Bosnia and Herzegovina, stressing that FIPA is the main address for foreign investors in BiH, which helps investors to realize their investment. The projects of BiH were presented on this occasion and they have attracted great interest from the present investors, who requested additional information on the business environment for foreign investors from the relevant representatives. Besides the FIPA Director, the conference was also attended by the President of the Chamber of Commerce of FBiH Marko Šantić, Mayor of the Municipality of Posušje Branko Bago and Director of the Regional Development Agency for Herzegovina Mirna Jelčić.



AWARDS FOR BIH AT THE WORLD ANNUAL INVESTMENT MEETING IN DUBAI


At the World Annual Investment Meeting (AIM), which is being held in Dubai from 8 to 10 April, with more than 20,000 people from the world business participating this year, the Foreign Investment Promotion Agency of BiH (FIPA) has been declared the best Agency for Attracting Foreign Investments for Central and Eastern Europe. At the same time, Al Shiddi Trading was named the best investor with his Swissotel Project in Sarajevo. The event is held under the auspices of HE Sheikh Mohammed Bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice-President of the United Arab Emirates and Prime Minister and Ruler of Dubai. The awards were received by Gordan Milinić and Abdullah Mohammed Al Shiddi, and the Ambassador of BiH to the United Arab Emirates Šerif Mujkanović was also present at the ceremony. At a special ceremony, AIM Investment Awards were awarded to selected Investment Promotion Agencies (IPAs) from every region of the world as recognition for their excellent work in successfully attracting significant and useful direct foreign investment projects in 2018, and contributing to economic growth and market development.

As a criteria for selecting the best IPAs and investment projects, a commission of 9 international experts was established, who evaluated each of the nominated projects that were short-listed, using criteria such as: size of investment, effects of investments on economic development, knowledge transfer, investor service process, sustainability and links with the local community and the economy, and the impact of digitization on attracting foreign direct investments. Representatives of institutions and companies from 150 countries of the world from different sectors such as food production, metal processing, energy, tourism, real estate, finance, construction, information technology, pharmacy, participate in this event, including representatives of IPAs from around the world who participate there in order to establish new contacts and to exchange experiences related to foreign investment policies, to improve competitiveness, promotion strategies, incentives for foreign investors.


GERMAN GIANT IN THE METAL INDUSTRY, RINGSPANN ANNOUNCED INVESTMENTS IN BIH

Ringspann is one of the leading manufacturers of drive components in Europe. Many well-known companies in mechanical and power engineering, materials handling, power generation and the aerospace industry are successfully collaborating with Ringspann. Among them are Rolls-Royce, BMW, Siemens, Tetra Pak ...

German company announced investments in the business zone of Pilana in the Municipality of Bosanska Krupa.

A few months ago, this company started production, mainly parts for electric bikes whose the biggest buyer is Bosch, and now, when it bought the land, it started building its own facilities.

The company is engaged in processing of parts of CNC machines. Currently, they have 22 employees. In the next two years, Ringspann plans to invest nearly two million EUR in the construction of production facilities in Bosanska Krupa.

SARAJEVO BUSINESS FORUM 2019

Sarajevo Business Forum (SBF), a three-day International Investment Conference, was held in Sarajevo from April 17 to 19, bringing around 2,000 participants from 50 countries. The conference brought together leading business and political leaders from the region and the world, as well as representatives of the BiH Diaspora. The special accent of this year's Forum was on the topic of sustainable development, and the digital revolution.

During the three-day Forum, presentations of businessmen and sponsors of the Forum were organized, as well as business (B2B) meetings for networking of participants and development of new business opportunities.

Special attention has been paid to the economic potentials of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the region, as well as the potentials of BiH diaspora and their investments.

The final day of the Forum was the final presentation of the youth competition SBF Start-up Challenge.



THE PROCEDURE FOR THE RENEWAL OF THE REGISTRATION OF FOOD PRODUCTION FACILITIES AT THE US FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION

According to the information of the American company "Registrer Corp" that provides services to businessmen and companies that export to the United States, the Embassy of Bosnia and Herzegovina to the United States informs that in comparison to last year there was a decrease in registered food production facilities by 20% owned by BiH companies, and export their products to the United States. These are companies registered with the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA).

We remind businessmen and companies from BiH that export to the United States to check whether the registration of the facilities has been properly done in order to export their products freely.


THE TREND OF THE INCREASE OF DIRECT FOREIGN INVESTMENTS IN BIH CONTINUED

According to the published preliminary data of the Central Bank of BH, foreign direct investments in 2018 reached the amount of BAM 800 million, which represents an increase of 2.8% compared to 2017 when BAM 777 million was recorded. The growth trend of foreign investments from 2017 continued in 2018. FIPA Director Gordan Milinić said that he was satisfied with this amount, because of the fact that last year was extremely difficult to attract foreign investors due to pre-election rhetoric that discouraged foreign investors, and frequent foreign investors' question whether their capital will be safe in Bosnia and Herzegovina. If it is to judge by the number of meetings and contacts that FIPA has held and established since the beginning of 2019, a trend of growth may also be expected in 2019. There are announcements of new investments this year, as well as a significant number of projects that started in 2018, and whose implementation continues in 2019. The start of the investment cycle will bring new jobs, employment of our citizens, more taxes to the state, new technologies, and strengthening the standards of living of our citizens. It is very important to point out that there are many obstacles on the way to a much larger inflow of foreign investments in BiH and a stronger investment increase that needs to be eliminated if the objective is to achieve a greater degree of employment in the country, strengthening the economy and development of the country. It is important to continue with the reform processes and to show willingness and will to improve the country's opportunities. Growth in investment and employment is a sufficient motivation to continue improving the country's business environment in a way that stimulates business people, improves the country's competitiveness and image. FIPA, within its Post-Investment Support Program, is preparing a proposal of measures that all BiH authorities should undertake to improve the business environment and facilitate business for foreign investors. Proposals have already been addressed to the competent authorities, after which they will be submitted to the final consideration of the Council of Ministers of BiH. In order to attract new investors and improve the image of the country, FIPA continues the implementation of the media campaign "Invest in BiH" in the world, which includes diplomatic and consular representations of BiH and foreign embassies in Sarajevo, and in which significant funds for advertising in the world's media should be invested.

BEING THE CROSSROADS OF MANY CIVILIZATIONS, BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA IS RICH WITH ARCHAEOLOGICAL REMAINS, FROM THE NEOLITHIC, ROMAN, ILLYRIAN AND MEDIEVAL PERIODS.

THE MOST SPECIFIC AND WELL KNOWN ARE THE HAND-CARVED TOMBSTONES (STEĆAK) THAT DATE BACK OVER 700 YEARS TO THE MIDDLE AGES. THESE UNIQUE MONUMENTS OF ANCIENT NATIVE ARTISTIC TRADITION, WHICH ARE SCATTERED ALL AROUND BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA, HAVE BECOME ALMOST A NATIONAL SYMBOL. IN ADDITION, THERE ARE NUMEROUS REMAINS OF MEDIEVAL TOWNS AND CASTLES FROM SAME PERIOD.

MOSTAR OLD BRIDGE, IN THE OLD TOWN IN THE VERY CENTRE OF MOSTAR, WAS BUILT IN 1566, BY THE OTTOMAN ARCHITECT, MIMAR HAJRUDIN, WHO ERECTED THIS STONE BRIDGE IN WHAT WAS THEN JUST A SMALL TURKISH OUTPOST IN SOUTHERN BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA.

THE BRIDGE SPANS THE EMERALD GREEN WATERS OF THE NERETVA RIVER AND CAME TO BE KNOWN AS “STARI MOST”, OR OLD BRIDGE. THE OUTPOST GREW INTO A CITY AND WAS EVENTUALLY NAMED AFTER THE BRIDGE - MOSTAR, OR “KEEPER OF THE BRIDGE.” TODAY, THIS BRIDGE IS INCLUDED IN THE UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE LIST. POČITELJ IS A UNIQUE SETTLEMENT, LISTED AS A POTENTIAL UNESCO HERITAGE SITE. THE HADI-ALIJA MOSQUE HAS BEEN RECONSTRUCTED AS WELL AS THE ŠIŠMAN-IBRAHIMPAŠINA MEDRESA AND THE GAVRAN KAPETANOVI HOUSE, ALL OF WHICH ARE OPEN TO VISITORS.

THE MOST STRIKING OBJECT IN POČITELJ IS THE SAHAT-KULA, A SILO-SHAPED FORT THAT TOWERS FROM THE TOP OF THE HILL ABOVE THE TOWN. IT HOUSED WATCHMEN AND MILITARY TO GUARD AGAINST POSSIBLE INVASION FROM THE NERETVA VALLEY. BESIDES ITS STUNNING ORIENTAL ARCHITECTURE AND OTTOMAN FEEL, POITELJ HOSTS THE LONGEST OPERATING ART COLONY IN SOUTH EASTERN EUROPE.

IT IS OFTEN DESCRIBED AS AN ANCIENT OUTDOOR MUSEUM WITH A MAGICAL FOREST OF BEAUTIFUL 50-METER HIGH SPRUCE AND BEECH, 200 TO 300 YEAR OLD, TREES. THE FOREST IS A TRUE GEM IN TERMS OF WILDLIFE AND THE LARGE NUMBER OF ENDEMIC PLANTS.

UNSURPRISINGLY, THE OTTOMAN SULTAN WAS IMPRESSED, AND ORDERED A TEKİJA TO BE BUILT RIGHT NEXT TO IT. THIS 16TH CENTURY HOUSE/MONASTERY WAS BUILT FOR THE DERVISH CULTS AND IS STILL ONE OF THE MOST MYSTICAL PLACES IN ALL OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA.

RAKITNICA RIVER CANYON IS ONE OF THE DEEPEST AND MOST PROFOUND GORGES IN EUROPE. IT IS A NATURAL WONDERLAND. THE ENTIRE LENGTH OF THE CANYON IS LINED WITH ENDEMIC TYPES OF FLORA AND FAUNA. BEARS, WOLVES, WILD BOAR, PINE MARTINS, AND WILD GOATS ALL TAKE REFUGE IN THIS DIFFICULT TO ACCESS CANYON.

AS MANY AS 32 ENDEMIC PLANTS, FLOWERS, AND TREES CAN BE FOUND IN THIS TINY REGION OF THE DINARIC ALPS. THE CRYSTAL CLEAR WATER, FED BY THE HIGH MOUNTAINS ABOVE, IS POTABLE WIDTH=100% FOR THE WHOLE LENGTH OF THE CANYON REGION.

VJETRENICA CAVES, NEAR THE SMALL TOWN OF RAVNO AND THE MEDIEVAL ORTHODOX MONASTERY OF ZAVALA IS THE LARGEST CAVE SYSTEM DISCOVERED IN BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA. THIS EXTENSIVE CAVE SYSTEM HAS OVER 6 KILOMETRES OF CHANNELS, AND THE STUNNING MAIN CHANNEL STRETCHES OVER 2.5 KILOMETRES.

AMONGST THE MANY ARCHEOLOGICAL DISCOVERIES ARE THE ANCIENT CAVE DRAWINGS OF BEARS AND LEOPARDS THAT ARE ESTIMATED TO BE OVER 10,000 YEARS OLD. THE MANY SMALL LAKES IN THE CAVES ARE HOME TO ENDEMIC TYPES OF SHELLFISH ONLY FOUND IN DEEP UNDERGROUND AQUIFER SYSTEMS. (READ MORE ON : WWW.BHTOURISM.BA)

ARCHAEOLOGICAL EXCAVATIONS BEGAN RECENTLY NEAR SARAJEVO IN THE VISOKO VALLEY AT WHAT SOME BELIEVE TO BE A NEWLY DISCOVERED PYRAMID COMPLEX, THE FIRST SUCH MONUMENTAL ANCIENT STRUCTURES FOUND IN EUROPE.

IN 2005, SEMIR OSMANAGIĆ PUT FORWARD HIS THEORY THAT A 100-METER GEOMETRICALLY-SHAPED HILL WITH EVENLY SHAPED SIDES AND CORNERS THAT POINT NORTH, SOUTH, EAST AND WEST IS AN ANCIENT MAN-MADE STRUCTURE.
